J5-J1 JUNIOR RACING (AGES 8 - 18)

Crotched Mountain's sanctioned racing team is for young athletes who want to improve their racing skills. Our experienced coaches will bring them to the next level of racing with a fun and comprehensive training program. The Crotched Mountain Race Club participates in the Buddy Werner and N.H. Alpine Racing Association (NHARA) in New Hampshire and New England...including the Buddy Werner Championships, J5 level (ages 8,9 & 10), J4 (ages 11 & 12), J3(ages 13 & 14), J2 (ages 15 & 16) and J1 (ages 17 & 18). Practice time is Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 am - 2:30 pm, starting early December 2011. J5-1 program also includes training one night per week . Parent volunteer requirements for jr race events.

TRAIN TO RACE (AGES 6 - 12)

The train-to-race program is geared toward younger skiers looking to improve their skills on the overall mountain and develop experience with running gates. This program is for Children and young teens transitioning from the tigers program onto the race team. It will run for 13 weeks starting mid December. Helmets are required. Program days will be Saturday and Sunday from 9:30am - 12:30 pm with one optional mid-week night during the program. Some children may participate in USSA events with head coach approval. The program is developed with the USSA model that provides sound technical coaching, an appropriate amount of gate training and a few race starts. Children are free to ski with family and friends in the afternoons, continuing to develop their enthusiasm, skills and passion for a life time of skiing. 1. CLUB LESSONS

All school programs with lesson participants will select their preferred scheduled lesson times during the enrollment process. Lesson times on the day of the program will be determined by the school program organizer in conjunction with the snow-sports director. This policy is meant to keep group sizes manageable and to ensure that students have the same group/instructor each week. Make-up days will be added upon completion of the planned sessions, if needed, and must be completed as a group. Parent pass 5-week lesson participants will be able to take lessons any day at the normal scheduled group lesson times at the mountain (10am, 1pm, 3pm & 5pm). Parents will not be allowed to take lessons with the school programs...NO EXCEPTIONS. No individual make-up lessons will be given. School program lessons cannot be taken on weekends or Holidays.

2. LESSON TIMES

Exact lesson times and levels offered may vary slightly from day-to-day depending on the arrival times of the schools/groups on that day. The number of students in each level will determine which levels are available in each lesson period. Once lesson configuration is set, it will continue in that format for the five weeks. Lessons will last one (1) hour. New skiers/snowboarders will receive their lessons on arrival, while more experienced skiers/snowboarders may have a "free ski" period before their lesson. Lesson times will be posted at the Snowsports Desk before your arrival on the first day. No individual lesson make-ups.

3. CANCELLATION POLICY

If the ski area and the school are both open on the scheduled day, the program will be held. If either the area or the school is not open, the program will be postponed and a make-up date will be scheduled. Changes in weather and snow conditions are part of the skiing experience, and learning how to handle such differences is part of learning how to ski well. Area management reserves the right to make decisions concerning cancellations and make-ups of the program for any other reasons. Make-up days will be determined by the Snowsports Dept. Please contact Snowsports for cancellations and/or to schedule a group make-up lesson.

4. CLUB CLOSEOUT & PAYMENTS

At time of club close-out, the mountain will accept credit card or a check (from schools only) for the remaining balance. Participants that would like to pay with a check must make check payable to the club coordinator or school program. The mountain will not accept personal checks from individual program participants.

5. PROGRAM BENEFITS

Organizers of School & Club programs are eligible to receive benefits based on package sales. Non-school groups, "clubs", are eligible for the 7% benefit package only. Schools with lesson programs are eligible to choose either the 7% benefit package, or an alternate package consisting of a structure of season passes and chaperone passes based on club sales.
